

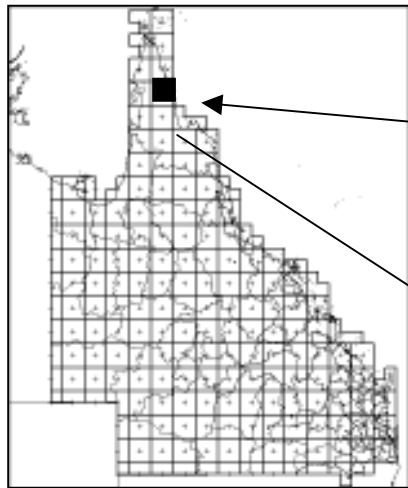

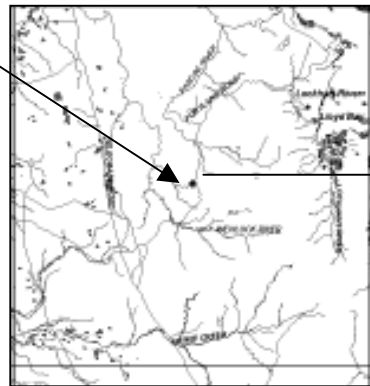
# Queensland by Degrees



## What is Queensland By Degrees?



Help us create a comprehensive and unique geography of Queensland to celebrate our State's 150<sup>th</sup> Birthday!! This project involves students, teachers and others recording geographical descriptions of the **185** points in Queensland where whole degree lines of latitude and longitude intersect, eg 13° S 143° E. One can **visit** the points or **research** one or more of them from home/school. This will provide a visual record eg photographs and written information showing the character, dynamics and interaction of Queensland's places.
