

J.P. Thomson Medallists

Through most of the Thomson medal's history, only one category of medal has been awarded. Exceptions are for 1957 and 1963 – gold and bronze medals awarded; and 1985 to 1989 – gold, silver and bronze medals awarded. Numerous medals were struck on occasions of importance to the Society, for example its 1985 Centenary.
